This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. KZRV has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2021 Stratus and 2021 SportTrek models. As a result, KZRV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however, your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

**Reason for  
this recall**

The vehicles subject to this recall were built with an incorrect circuit breaker. Under certain conditions the wiring could overheat and melt before the circuit breaker trips and could result in a fire that results in property damage, personal injury or death.

**What we  
will do**

The remedy is to change the 20 amp circuit breaker which controls the water heater circuit with the proper 15 amp circuit breaker. The repair should take approximately 30 minutes to complete. The repair will be completed free of charge.

**What we need  
you to do**

You should contact your selling dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the defect repaired in your vehicle. If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from KZRV by contacting the **KZRV Warranty/Service Department**.
