



# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2021 model year Chevrolet Tahoe and GMC Yukon vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

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**Why is your vehicle being recalled?** Dealer service technicians programmed these vehicles' brake system control modules (BSCM) with incorrect calibrations. This condition adversely impacts the operation or sensitivity of certain vehicle systems, including electronic stability control, traction control, and anti-lock braking, or cause the loss of trailer braking while towing, increasing the risk of a crash.

**What will we do?** Your GM dealer will reprogram the brake system control module with the correct software and calibration data files free of charge. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of approximately 25 minutes.

**What should you do?** You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
