
1. Verify that the vehicle is within the following ranges:

- If the vehicle is one of the above listed, proceed to Step 2.
- If the vehicle is not within the above ranges, return vehicle to the customer or inventory.
- 2. Perform a Warranty Vehicle Inquiry using your eMDCS System and inspect vehicle for Campaign Labels **Recall 5221I** attached to the vehicle's hood. Refer to eMDCS System Warranty Vehicle Inquiry Results table below.

**NOTE:** Be sure to verify Recall number as the vehicle may have multiple Recall labels.




### A. Disconnect the negative battery terminal

Do **NOT** press the walk-in button on the side of the second-row seat while removing the seat. (on equipped models only)





1. Remove the front adjuster cover No.1 of the 60-split seat. (2pcs.) \*\*Please refer to the instruction below to remove the adjuster cover.






#### Note:

When the seat is not fixed to the vehicle, do not lift the slider lever more than 15 mm (9/16"). If the slider lever is operated too far, the left and right sliders may not be aligned, and if the 60 Split seat is reinstalled with the left/right sliders deviated, the adjuster unit could be damaged. If the left/right slide positions are not aligned, it will be necessary to synchronize and align sliders.





2. Stick the hair felt (thickness: 3 mm) on the bracket where the rubber was installed.

- 3. Degrease the bracket.
- 4. Match the edge of the hair felt to the edge/corner of the bracket and cover the bracket with the hair felt while matching the centerline of the hair felt and the bracket.
- 5. Stick the felt together and ensure part is sticking out from each side of the bracket.






Underside of bracket prior to sticking the felt on permanently











# 4. Operation check and Inspection of Link Lever

2. Operate the slider lever and make sure that the link lever and component parts work as designed.





# **Procedure of Slider synchronizing**


**Caution:** Make sure to hold the left side slider when operating the slider lever. When operating the slider lever and releasing the slide lock, the slider will move rapidly due to the force of the slider spring.



A. Lift the slider lever and move the right-side slider upward to the end



**B.** Move the right-side slider downward to the end.

**C.** Repeat the same operations in steps B and C on the left side slider. Slider synchronizing is completed.
