**Replace Airbag Control Unit** 

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2020 GLS-Class vehicles (X167 platform), the airbag control unit software might not meet current production specifications. If the vehicle's airbag control unit software does not meet current production specifications, in the event of a crash with activation of driver's frontal airbag, the risk of injury to the driver might increase. MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the airbag control unit, which includes the correct software, on the affected vehicles.

### Prior to performing this Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Approximately 3 vehicles are affected.

## **Replace Airbag Control Unit**

Model 167

- i
  - Ensure use of XENTRY Diagnosis version BD/DVD (06/2021) or higher.
  - Before starting the work procedure, install the current version of all add-ons in XENTRY Diagnosis.
  - Make sure to follow the operation steps exactly as described in XENTRY Diagnosis.
  - Use a battery charger to ensure sufficient power supply of the vehicle's **on-board electrical system battery** (greater than 12.5 V).
  - If XENTRY Diagnosis is already connected to the vehicle, start with operation step 2.

If two or more software updates or SCN codings are performed during one workshop visit, operation items 02-4762 and 02-5058 may be invoiced only once for each workshop order.

### **Work Procedure**

1.	Replace Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) control unit (AR91.60-P-0624ME).
