IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL (Interim Notice)

Certain 2013 through 2015 Model Year Porsche Boxster and Cayman Vehicles NHTSA ID 21V-679

Dear Mr.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the <u>National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act</u>. Porsche has determined that certain 2013 to 2015 Model Year Porsche Boxster and Cayman Vehicles have a potential issue with the wishbone control arm mounts on the rear suspension of the vehicle.

You received this notice because our records, which are based primarily on state registration and title data, indicate that you are the current owner of a vehicle affected by this recall.

What is the issue?

There is a possibility that rear suspension control arm mounts that do not meet the required specifications were installed on the rear suspension of the vehicle. If this is the case, one or both wishbone mounts on the rear suspension can break, which could cause loss of control of the vehicle.

What will Porsche do?

Porsche is conducting a safety recall to replace both of the rear suspension control arm mounts on the vehicle, free of charge once parts become available.

What should you do?

You can continue to use your vehicle until the remedy has been carried out. Porsche recommends against use on race tracks before the remedy has been completed.

Please wait for our follow up letter to bring your vehicle into a dealer for a remedy.
