


IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This INTERIM notice applies to your vehicle,

Update Engine Control Unit Software

NHTSA Recall #21V843

December, 2021



Dear Mercedes-Benz Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year ("MY") 2021 S-Class and Maybach vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles.

What is the Concern?

In certain MY21 S-Class and Maybach vehicles, the engine control unit software might not meet current production specifications. In this case, the vehicle may stall shortly after engine start, and a subsequent restart might not be possible. This might occur suddenly without warning, and independent of the driving situation, which could increase the risk of a crash.

An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the engine control unit software on the affected vehicles.

Unfortunately, the software to remedy this is not yet available. We are working to obtain the necessary software to correct this condition as quickly as possible. When the software becomes available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer to have the recall completed free of charge.

Should you have any concerns or questions regarding your vehicle before you receive the next recall letter when the software is available, please contact an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer. If for any reason a dealer is unable to remedy your situation, we are always happy to hear from you. Please contact us at 1-800-367-6372. A vehicle identification number (VIN)-based recall lookup tool on our MBUSA.com website offers a search function that will indicate whether a vehicle has been subject to a safety recall, and whether that vehicle has had the free remedy performed. Please visit www.MBUSA.com/recall.

If you are no longer the vehicle owner, or have a change of address, please complete the reverse side of this letter and return the complete letter in the enclosed envelope. If this is a leased vehicle and the lessor and registered owner receive this notice, please forward this information by first class mail to the lessee within 10 days to comply with federal regulations.

If a Mercedes-Benz dealer for any reason is unable to remedy the situation without charge, or within a reasonable amount of time, pursuant to law 49 U.S.C. Chapter 301, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20590 or call the toll-free Auto Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY 1-800-424-9153); or go to http://www.safercar.gov.
