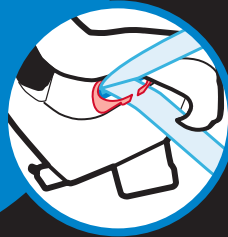




REAR FACING
Lower Anchor Belt
or Vehicle Belt
Goes Here



When used rear facing, only the lap portion of the vehicle belt or the lower anchor belt **MUST** be threaded into the belt positioning guide on both sides of shell.

DO NOT thread the shoulder portion of the lap/shoulder belt into the belt positioning guides.

REAR FACING

⚠ WARNING! DEATH or SERIOUS INJURY can occur:

- Use only in a rear-facing position when using it with an infant weighing less than 22 pounds (10 kg).
- Use only with children who weigh between 14 and 40 pounds (6.4 and 18 kg) and whose height is 40 inches (101.6 cm) or less.
- Snugly adjust the belts provided with this child restraint around your child.
- Secure this child restraint with the vehicle's child restraint anchorage system if available or with a vehicle belt.
- Follow all instructions on this child restraint and in the written instructions located in the pad on the side of child restraint.
- Register your child restraint with the manufacturer.

FORWARD FACING

⚠ WARNING! DEATH or SERIOUS INJURY can occur:

- Use only with children who weigh between 22 and 65 pounds (10.1 and 29 kg) and whose height is between 29 and 49 inches (73.6 and 125 cm) and who are at least 1 year old.
- Snugly adjust the belts provided with this child restraint around your child.
- Secure the top anchorage strap provided with this child restraint.
- Secure this child restraint with the vehicle's child restraint anchorage system if available or with a vehicle belt.
- Do not use the lower anchors of the child restraint anchorage system (LATCH system) to attach this child restraint when restraining a child weighing more than 40 lbs (18 kg).
- Follow all instructions on this child restraint and in the written instructions located in the pad on the side of child restraint.
