| November 4, 2021 | Kia Corporation (Kia HQ) informs Kia North America (Kia NA) Safety Office of a potential issue with the passenger side Power Sliding Door (PSD) not closing properly based on customer complaints in the Korean market. |
| November 8—November 10, 2021 | Kia NA Safety Office conducts an evaluation of field data associated with PSD not latching and identifies two (2) warranty claims, two (2) customer complaints and one (1) techline case relating to three (3) unique VINs. |
| November 11, 2021 | Kia NA Safety Office shares its field data information with Kia HQ and seeks further clarification as to potential cause of issue and warnings provided to the customer upon occurrence. |
| November 12-15, 2021 | <p>Kia NA conducts evaluation of potential safety issue associated with the PSD opening while driving condition in light of numerous warnings provided to customer.</p> <p>Kia HQ works with supplier and identifies the plastic holder inside the release actuator was manufactured out of specification. Kia HQ and the supplier confirm affected vehicle scope is 7/28/21 through 10/26/21.</p> <p>Kia NA holds 2022MY Carnival vehicles produced from 10/15/21 through 10/26/21 at the port.</p> |
| November 16, 2021 | Kia NA decides to conduct safety recall. No fatalities, injuries, crashes or fires. Two (2) warranty claims, two (2) customer complaints and one (1) techline case. |
