# **Problem Description:**

Streamline Industries Incorporated (Streamline) is recalling certain LA Chopper +2 length ABS Kit Midnight, part number OEM-LA-8211B-13M and +5 Non ABS Brake Kit Black, part number OEM-LA-8153B-13-B. The hydraulic brake hoses may be missing the identification label. As such, these brake hoses fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard number 106, "Brake Hoses."

# **Consequence:**

Brake hoses with missing labels may not be identified in the event of a safety recall, potentially resulting in an unremedied safety issue and an increased risk of a crash or injury.

# **Remedy:**

Streamline will provide a band with the labeling information, or replace the brake hoses, free of charge. Owner notification letters are expected to be mailed May 20, 2022. Owners may contact Streamline customer service at 1-800-310-5519.

An identification and description of the risk to motor vehicle safety reasonably related to the defect or noncompliance (49 CFR 573.6 (c)(5)). All filings should state an increased risk of either a crash, injury or fire.

#### AMENDED 573 REQUIRED.

In the case of items of motor vehicle equipment, the manufacturer of the equipment shall identify by name, business address, and business telephone number every manufacturer that purchases the defective or noncomplying component for use or installation in new motor vehicles or new items of motor vehicle equipment (49 CFR 573.6 (c)(2)(v)).

#### AMENDED 573 REQUIRED.

Please be reminded of the following requirements:

You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of eight consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on, or before, 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
