Chronology:

Newmar Corporation is reporting this recall following the notification from a dealer on 9/12/22 that a driver delivering a unit noticed brake pedal catching the dash panel when it was extended towards him in the driver seat. This was causing the brakes to drag on the motorhome.

On 9/13/22 Newmar production tested the brake pedal by extending it out completely towards the driver and noticed the interference with the dash panel.

On 9/14/22 the Newmar Warranty Reduction team was notified of the problem to start working on a review of the issue and next steps to be taken.

On 9/20/22 and Engineering change order was written to trim the dash panel in the area of the brake pedal to give more clearance and removed the chance of any interference of the brake pedal with the dash panel. The was implemented immediately in production and all units still on Newmar property already through production also had the dash panel trimmed.

All of this information was presented to the Safety Committee on 10/5/2022 and at that time it was decided to file a recall for this issue.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Newmar Corporation will be conducting this recall in its entirety. Units

identified as having the brake pedal interference problem will have the dash panel trimmed to add more clearance at the brake pedal and dash panel. This will remove any chance of future brake pedal interference with

the dash panel. All work will be at no cost to customer.
