Description of the Defect : General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in certain 2021 – 2022 model year Chevrolet Silverado Medium Duty 4500HD/5500HD/6500HD vehicles. Navistar, the manufacturer of these vehicles, has determined that certain hex flange lock nuts used in several locations in the suspension joints in these vehicles were not properly formed and heat treated by its supplier.

Description of the Safety Risk : Improperly manufactured nuts can result in a loss of joint tension over time. A loss of tension in the suspension joints may increase the risk of a crash.

**Chronology :**

On November 18, 2022, Navistar informed GM that it was investigating a quality issue in certain hex flange lock nuts used in 2021-2022 model year Chevrolet Silverado Medium Duty vehicles, and that it had decided to conduct a safety recall to address this condition in Navistar-badged vehicles in the field. After consulting with Navistar, GM's Safety Field Action Decision Authority (SFADA) decided to conduct a safety recall on November 22, 2022.

**Description of Remedy :**

Description of Remedy Program : Dealers will replace suspect lock nuts.  
Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 573.13(d)(1), all covered vehicles are under warranty, so reimbursement is not offered.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : Replacement lock nuts are made to Navistar's specified form and surface hardness.
