Description of the Safety Risk: Due to inaccurate trailer weight, an owner could unintentionally load the

travel trailer beyond it's intended capacity.

Description of the Cause: Travel trailer weight data was entered incorrectly in the production process

which resulted in an inaccurate cargo carrying capacity.

Chronology:

In late August 2022, Winnebago investigated a customer complaint regarding an alleged incorrect weight label. During that investigation, it was determined that the cargo carrying capacity label on that trailer was incorrect. A subsequent broader investigation was initiated to determine if there were other coaches potentially impacted. Upon completion of that investigation, the Product Safety Committee met to review the findings and decided that incorrect cargo carrying capacity labels posed a non-compliance with a federal standard 49 CFR 571.110 and 120 and therefore initiated a voluntary non-compliance recall.

Winnebago is not aware of any accidents or injuries resulting from this non-compliance.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: New cargo carrying capacity labels will be printed and shipped to

customers with impacted serial numbers.

Reimbursement requests will fall under the general reimbursement plan
