Issue:	In certain vehicles, the long fuel injectors may have been assembled without filter						
	element. An injector built without filter element may leak, and fuel may enter into the engine compartment. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source, may increase the risk of a fire.						
Precautions:	If the recall condition is present in the vehicle, customers may recognize a fuel odor or notice fuel leakage. Additionally, the check engine light may illuminate. If this happens, customers are advised to contact an authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to have the vehicle inspected/repaired.
