



# **SAFETY RECALL NOTICE STOP SALE COMMUNICATION**

Date: April 26, 2022

**To: All U.S. Maserati Dealers**  
**Subject: Safety Recall 501 – MY 2022 Maserati MC20 vehicles.**

Effective immediately, the vehicles listed on MODIS for this campaign recall must not be delivered to customers. The subject vehicles are included in a voluntary safety recall related to certain tail lamp assemblies installed in the rear part of the vehicle causing the stop lamps to flicker under certain braking conditions, which may cause confusion to drivers following the vehicles, which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

For vehicles in the recall the component labels will have to be inspected, and if necessary, to replace the tail lamp assemblies. Maserati intends to notify owners on or before 06/03/2022 to schedule appointments to have their vehicles fixed.

The remedy for this condition is currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch on or before June 3, 2022.

**Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied. Violation of this requirement by could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. You must correct all vehicles in your new vehicle inventory before delivery.**
