



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – Z41

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 Model Year (WL) Jeep® Grand Cherokee and Grand Cherokee L vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may flash the hazard lights during certain braking events. If the hazard lights flash during a braking event, following drivers may become confused by the additional lighting, which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard ("FMVSS") 108 Table 1-a which requires that stop lamps shall be "steady burning." Vehicles that activate the hazard lights when the brake pedal is applied are not steady burning.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to update configuration parameters in the body control module. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2022.
