AUTOCAR, LLC SAFETY RECALL ACX-2203 NHTSA RECALL NO. 22V437

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2143, 2019–2022 model year Xpeditor (ACX) chassis. These chassis were manufactured between March 13, 2019, and November 1, 2021, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range of 229795 through 237892.accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective July 29, 2022.

MODELS Autocar Xpeditor (ACX) MY 2019-2022

AFFECTED:

COMPONENTS AFFECTED:

The external fuse box may short circuit due to water intrusion.

SAFETY DEFECTS AND POTENTIAL RISKS: If the external fuse box short circuits the vehicle may stall unexpectedly and not restart, increasing the risk of property damage, personal injury, or a crash.

REPAIR REQUIRED:

The external fuse box will be remounted vertically, and a shield attached to match current production at no charge to the owner.

<u>REPAIR</u> <u>AVAILABLE:</u> VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on July 29, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the Warranty system.

REMINDER:

It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
