Background				
Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2022 EQS-Class (297 platform) vehicles, the threaded towing point in the front and/or rear bumper might not meet current production specifications. In this case, the required thread depth for the tow eye might not be sufficient. As a result, it cannot be ruled out that the connection to the tow eye may loosen when installed, which could increase the risk of an accident or injury during vehicle loading and transport.		
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the thread of the tow points on the affected vehicles and replace, if necessary.
