

NHTSA Recall No. 22V-529

September 5, 2022

To: All Ember Recreational Vehicle Dealers

Ember Recreational Vehicles has determined that a safety defect exists in certain Overland series recreational vehicles. A recall to address this problem is being initiated effective September 5, 2022.

The defect involves 2022 191MDB, 190MDB, 170MBH, and 170MRB floorplans manufactured between October 18, 2021, and March 24, 2022. The VIN range of affected units is:

7RVTV1228NA000010 to 7RVTV1220NA000062 (non-sequential)
7RVTV1221NA000085 to 7RVTV1227NA000110 (non-sequential)
7RVTV1207NA000591 to 7RVTV1207NA000638 (non-sequential)

On affected vehicles, the Enerco/Flex-Tech LP quick disconnect fitting may crack when in use, causing a gas leak. A gas leak in the presence of an ignition source can increase the risk of a fire. Repair involves replacing the Enerco/Flex-Tech LP quick disconnect.

Owners of affected vehicles will be notified of this recall by mail from Ember Recreational Vehicles. A copy of the Customer Notification Letter is attached for your reference. Also attached are the repair instructions associated with this recall action.



Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal Law for you to sell or lease the products covered by this notification until the necessary repairs have been performed.
