

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

AUTOCAR, LLC ACX-2205 NHTSA RECALL NO. 22V697

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 236, 2022 model year Xpeditor (ACX), chassis manufactured between October 4, 2021, and February 7, 2022, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range of 238165 through 239112. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective November 15, 2022.

COMPONENTS The tie rod clamps may have been improperly heat treated and may fail structurally.

If the tie rod tube clamp fails or becomes loose the threaded tie rod ends could become loose and potentially disconnect resulting in a sudden loss of steering, increasing the risk of a crash.

The tie rod tube clamps will be replaced at no charge to the owner.

VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on November 15, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the
