This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC ("Seagrave"), has determined that a potential safety defect exists in certain Capitol and Marauder model firetrucks, manufactured by Seagrave between January 2022 through September 2022.

Description of Defect

Seagrave is conducting this recall to address an issue whereby the vehicles listed below may contain tie rod clamps that were improperly heat treated and are prone to cracking. A cracked tie rod clamp can cause a loss of steering control, increasing the risk of a crash. Seagrave will replaced the tie rod clamps with properly heat treated clamps free of charge.

The Seagrave vehicles listed below are suspect of containing the recalled condition described above. Please make an appointment at your earliest convenience with your local Seagrave service facility to perform the needed remedy. The remedy repair will take approximately (30) minutes and be performed at no cost to you.
