

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

AUTOCAR, LLC ACX-2206 NHTSA RECALL NO. 22V797

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2136, 2021-2023 model year Xpeditor (ACX) chassis manufactured between January 4, 2021, and April 1, 2022, with nonsequential serial numbers in the range of 234541 through 241051. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective December 20, 2022.

Autocar Xpeditor (ACX) MY 2021 - 2023 **MODELS**

AFFECTED:

COMPONENTS The steering column shaft pinch bolt may not be properly secured.

AFFECTED:

SAFETY If the steering column shaft pinch bolt is not properly secured, it could come into DEFECTS AND contact with cab components and cause the steering to bind, resulting in a sudden

POTENTIAL loss of steering, increasing the risk of a crash. **RISKS:**

The steering column shaft pinch bolts will be replaced and secured at no charge to REPAIR

REQUIRED: the owner.

VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on **REPAIR AVAILABLE:**

December 20, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the

Warranty system.

It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice **REMINDER:**

unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to

violations of this law.
