Issue:

Incorrect windshield wiper (front) software was installed during vehicle production and, in rare cases, the wipers may not be activated due to a software fault. This is noncompliant with regulatory requirements. If the windshield wipers cannot be activated, it may lead to reduced visibility for the driver and may increase the risk of a crash.

Repair:

- REPAIR AVAILABLE December 08, 2022 / Update the body control module software.
- See ELSA/ServiceNet for complete repair & claiming instructions
- Check both the daily Campaign Open Inventory report and OMD for affected vehicles in inventory. Verify OPEN status in ELSA on the day of repair.
- Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers.

Parts Department:

Software update only, no parts needed.

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
