Noncompliance Recall Bulletin Temporarily Suspended for Additional Select Models

To: All General Motors Dealers

On January 17, 2023 we temporarily suspended 2022-2023 model year Cadillac Escalade and Escalade ESV, Chevrolet Suburban and Tahoe, GMC Yukon and Yukon XL. The suspension is still in effect for those models. Effective January 18, 2023, the 2022-2023 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 New and GMC Sierra 1500 New have been added to the population of vehicles that are suspended.

Involved vehicle status in IVH will be temporarily changed from “Open” to “Incomplete, Remedy Not Available”. Dealers will be notified when repairs can be resumed. We apologize for any inconvenience this situation may cause.

For vehicles in “Incomplete, Remedy Not Available” status, it is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification until the noncompliance is remedied.

Until further instructions are received, involved vehicles that are in dealers’ possession (new or used vehicle inventory, GM Certified Used, courtesy transportation vehicles, dealer shuttle vehicles, etc.) must be held and not delivered to customers, dealer-traded, released to auction, used for demonstration purposes or any other dealer use. All GM Certified Used vehicles currently in the dealers’ inventory within the Certified Pre-Owned Inventory System (CPOIS) will be de-certified.
