IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 22E-073

Dear Oshkosh Vehicle Owner:

Ref: NHTSA Steering Gear Assembled Incorrectly 22E-073

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Oshkosh has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in parts purchased for your Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Mixer. These parts were purchased between June, 2021-September, 2022 from MTM as service parts, in conjunction with a refurb, box frame or other service work.

!IMPORTANT!

- Your Oshkosh vehicle is being recalled.

- This recall repair will result in **no cost** to you.

Why is a recall being conducted?

A small number of steering gears were assembled without the required number of recirculating balls. The recall population was determined by identifying the oldest production lot associated with a gear failure, and including all production from that lot to the date in February 2022 when the improvements in the assembly process were instituted.

What are we doing about the problem?

Oshkosh will provide customers with Instructions on how to inspect for suspect serial numbers. If suspect part is found, customers would purchase the parts, perform the repairs, and then file parts/labor reimbursement through normal warranty process. Customers can also contact their nearest Oshkosh/McNeilus Service Center to schedule this inspection/repair at no charge.



What should you do?

- Inspection should take less than 1.0 hours.
- Repairs should take less than 4.0 hours.
- Customers can also contact their nearest Oshkosh/McNeilus Service Center to schedule this inspection/repair at no charge
