IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear **Customer Name**,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC (“Seagrave”), has determined that a potential safety defect exists in certain Capitol and Marauder model firetrucks, manufactured by Seagrave between December 2011 through December 2022.

Description of Defect

Seagrave is conducting this recall to address an issue whereby the crossmember behind the transmission may fatigue and possibly crack, potentially creating noises that could distract the driver, increasing the risk of a crash. Seagrave has determined that the root cause of this condition was due to the design of the crossmember. The condition is dependent on the driving conditions of each specific vehicle and may not be present on all suspected vehicles, but the condition has the potential to occur in the entire recall population.

The Seagrave vehicles listed below are suspect of containing the recalled condition described above. Please make an appointment at your earliest convenience with your local Seagrave service facility to perform the needed remedy. The remedy repair will take approximately (5) hours and be performed at no cost to you.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

We regret any inconvenience this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety.
