IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This Notice Applies to Your Recreational Vehicle «vin»

Dear Valued Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary, Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation, and Jayco motorized division have decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists on certain model year 2018-2023 Entegra Accolade, Accolade XL, Jayco Seneca, Seneca Prestige Class C motorhomes built with certain Freightliner model Years 2017 - 2023 FCCC MBC, MC, MT55, S2C, S2G, S2RV, XBR, XBS, XCL, XCM, XCR, and XCS chassis manufactured February 20, 2017, through November 18, 2021, and equipped with a valve stem extension and stabilizer configured with a specific tire valve stem and wheel combination.

Reason for this recall	Certain chassis may have been built with the tire valve stem extension for the inner wheel contacting the outer wheel rim opening, potentially damaging the valve stem resulting in a loss of air pressure in the inner tire. A loss of air pressure in the inner tire on a motorhome with a single drive axle may overload the outer tire and increase the risk of a crash.
Recall Remedy	Repairs will be performed by Daimler Trucks North America authorized service facilities. The inner valve stem extension and stabilizer will be removed. The Recall will take approximately one hour and will be performed at no charge to you.
What we need you to do	Please contact an authorized Daimler Trucks North America dealer to arrange to have the Recall performed and to ensure that parts are available at the dealership. To locate an authorized dealer, search online at Daimler-TrucksNorthAmerica.com/contact-us/. Scroll down to "Locate a Dealer," and select the appropriate brand. If you have paid to have this recall condition corrected prior to this notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement. Requests for reimbursement may include parts and labor. Reimbursement may be limited to the amount the repair would have cost if completed by an authorized Daimler Trucks North America LLC dealer. The following documentation must be presented to your dealer for consideration for reimbursement. Please provide original or clear copies of all receipts, invoices, and repair orders that show:

- 1. The name and address of the person who paid for the repair
- 2. The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) of the repaired vehicle
- 3. What problem occurred, what repair was done, and the date of the repair
- 4. Who repaired the vehicle
- 5. The total cost of the claimed repair expense
- 6. Proof of payment for the repair (such as the front and back of a cancelled check or a credit card receipt)

Reimbursement will be made by check from your Daimler Trucks North America LLC dealer. Please speak with your authorized Daimler Trucks North America LLC dealer concerning this matter.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s), which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days.
