Subject: Cascadia Braking Issue

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the *National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act*.

Daimler Truck North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division, has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2022 Freightliner Cascadia Vehicles manufactured October 28, 2021, through December 17, 2021.

The emergency braking system may not engage, which can result in the loss of braking ability, which increases the risk of a crash.

Vehicles will receive an additional double check valve installed at the foot pedal. Repairs will be completed by Daimler Truck North America authorized service facilities. The Recall will take approximately 1 hour and will be performed at no charge to you.

This is the second notice regarding this recall. The final recall repair is now available. Please contact an authorized Daimler Truck North America dealer to arrange to have the Recall performed and to ensure that parts are available at the dealership. To locate an authorized dealer, search online at Daimler-TruckNorthAmerica.com/Contact-us. Scroll down to "Locate a Dealer" and select the appropriate brand. If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s), which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days.
