Bentley Motors has decided that certain 2021-2022 model year Bentley Bentayga vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 111, Rear Visibility. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action

What is the issue? Due to a software error, the rearview camera image may be blank when

the car is placed in reverse. A rearview camera screen that displays a blank image reduces the driver's view of what is behind the vehicle, increasing

the risk of a crash.

What will we do? To correct this noncompliance, your authorized Bentley dealer will update

the infotainment unit software. This work will take about three and a half

hours to complete and will be performed for you free of charge.
