This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Airstream has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2017-2022 Basecamp 16' & model year 2021-2022 Basecamp 20' travel trailers. As a result, Airstream is conducting a safety recall.

Reason for this recall

Airstream, Inc. (Airstream) is recalling certain 2017-2022 Basecamp 16' & 2021-2022 Basecamp 20' travel trailers. The adhesive bond between the glass and metal frame of the entry door window may fail which would allow the glass to separate from the window frame. If this occurs, the glass could become a projectile, increasing the risk of a crash, personal injury and/or property damage.

What we will do

An inspection of the entry door window glass will occur. If the glass passes the inspection, and the proper trim fasteners are installed, then no further action needed. If the glass does not pass the inspection, or the proper fasteners are not installed on the top of the door, the items will be replaced. This will be done at no cost to the customer. This repair will take approximately .5 to 2.5 hrs.

What we need you to do

You should contact your selling dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the inspection performed on your vehicle. If you have had the appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Airstream by contacting the **Airstream Customer Service Department**.
