IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL – 4th Notice

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Our records indicate YOUR UNIT HAS NOT BEEN REMEDIED. Please DO NOT ignore this notice!

Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2022 Alpine, Arcadia, Avalanche, Fuzion, Impact, Passport Fifth Wheels and Travel Trailers. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population have a 50 amp shore power inlet with a #2 Philips lug that may have been improperly stamped, not allowing it to be properly torqued by the installer. Under certain conditions if the lug is not properly torqued to 20 inch pounds, the loose connection can lead to an increased risk of property damage or fire.

What we will do

Keystone representatives have been in contact with the staff at your selling dealership regarding this situation. The remedy is to remove the 50 amp shore receptacle on suspect vehicles and torque lugs to 20 inch pounds. If 20 inch pounds cannot be reached, the 50 amp shore receptacle is to be replaced. The service and parts required for this corrective action will be provided at no charge to you.

What we need you to do

Vehicles should be taken to an authorized dealer and the torque inspected on the 50 amp shore receptacle lugs before plugging the unit into shore power. As soon as possible, please make an appointment to have your RV serviced by your dealership. The labor time to perform this correction is approximately ½ hour. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your RV for this repair.

BE ADVISED -

Damage caused by failure to have the recall remedy completed will be the responsibility of the owner.

If you have questions

Your dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your RV is corrected as promptly as possible. Please contact Keystone Customer service if your dealer is unable to assist or if you take your RV to your dealer on the agreed service date, and the dealer does not remedy the condition within a reasonable amount of time, or without charge to you. You may be eligible to receive reimbursement if you paid to have the defect resolved prior to receiving this correspondence. Keystone Customer Service is available toll-free at 1-866-425-4369.
