This notice applies to your vehicle, JA4APUAU2MUXXXXXX.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Reason for notice: In August 2022 Mitsubishi Motors North America, Inc. (MMNA) announced a recall which relates to motor vehicle safety

> in certain 2019-2022 Outlander Sport vehicles equipped with continuously variable transmissions (CVT) and mechanical key ignition systems. A software error in the transmission control unit (CVT-ECU) may incorrectly reduce the transmission gear ratio at high speeds, which can result in an engine stall. An engine stall can increase the risk of a crash.

As of March 20, 2024, our records indicate your vehicle is still unrepaired.

What you should do: MMNA urges you to please contact your local Mitsubishi Motors dealer and schedule an appointment to have the CVT-

ECU reprogramed, free of charge. When you bring your vehicle in, please show the dealer this letter. If you misplace this

letter, the dealer will still perform this repair on your vehicle, free of charge.

What your dealer will do: The dealership will reprogram the CVT-ECU with modified software.

How long will it take? The time needed for the reprogramming is approximately 30 minutes. The dealer may need your vehicle for a longer

period of time, but every effort will be made to minimize your inconvenience.

If you experience any problem having your vehicle repaired promptly and/or at no charge, please inform us by calling the Mitsubishi Customer Relations Department at 888-648-7820. Hours: Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Central Time).

If, after contacting Mitsubishi Customer Relations, you still have a problem getting this repair made promptly and/or without charge, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, D.C. 20590, or call the tollfree Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153), or go to http://www.safercar.gov.

If you have already encountered a problem with the CVT-ECU and had it replaced as a result of this specific condition and have paid for the repair, you may send your original repair order or invoice, **and** original receipt/proof of payment to the following address for reimbursement consideration:
