Specific soldering points on the flexible printed circuit assembled (FPCA) inside the HV battery may not establish a reliable connection due to manufacturing issues. Unreliable connections inside the HV battery may lead to breakdowns or stalling while driving in the field. This can lead to a crash without warning.								
			Are there any precautions I should take because my vehicle is part of Safety Recall 9302?	If the recall issue is present in the vehicle, the driver would be alerted by a message appearing in the instrument panel warning about an issue in the high voltage system. Should this occur, customers are advised to contact an authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to make arrangements to have the vehicle diagnosed/repared.								
			What is the repair for the Safety Recall 9302?	To address this potential issue, your authorized Volkswagen dealer will replace the affected battery cell modules.
