On March 27, 2023, during a routine inspection at the manufacturing plant it was discovered that the safety chains were incorrectly rated for the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating ("GVWR") that is listed on the Federal Placard. On the same day it was determined there was a clerical error on the Federal Placard.

All vehicles affected are located at a single Dealer and have been quarantined. The replacement Federal Placards will be sent to the Dealer to be installed. None of the affected vehicles are sold to retail consumers. Therefore, there will not be an owner notification sent, only a Dealer Letter.
