Descriptive Information : Cummins Power Generation notified our company that certain serial numbers had a concern with the fuel line system. The number of effected generators that were sold to QVSV by the vendor was 10. Out of the 10 that were sold to us, 2 of them were in our inventory and returned to Cummings Power. Make/Model - Onan QG 2800i EVAP, Part no. 2.8HGLAA-8303A.

Description of the Defect : This fuel hose between the inline fuel filter and the Injection Pump Module (IPM) may have inadequate clamp force, possibly resulting in a gasoline leak.

Description of the Safety Risk : A gasoline leak in the presence of an ignition source may increase the risk of fire.

Description of the Cause : The cause of the issue is an inadequate specification of the fuel hose.

Chronology :

On April 14, 2013 Quality Vans & Specialty Vehicles was notified that a safety-related defect exists in certain Onan QG 2800i and Onan QG 2800i EVAP generators that were manufactured between March 3, 2020 and February 10, 2023. Cummins has initiated a recall of the subject generators. We shared the customer information to Cummins to send notification to our customers on April 20, 2023, and an updated list to Cummins on April 24, 2023. Quality Vans & Specialty Vehicles have received no reports of being found or been notified by customers of safety-related defects but have complied with the notification process. To date, there have been no reports of fires or injuries related to this issue. Quality Vans & Specialty Vehicles does not have dealers or distributors.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : The remedy is to inspect and, if the unit has the defect, to replace the subject fuel hose and associated clamps. A recall-specific reimbursement plan will be provided on the Recall Portal for those units not covered by the manufacturer's limited warranty.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : The remedy fuel hose has a unique part number A073T925.

Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production : Production began with the remedy fuel hose on 02/21/2023.
