SUBJECT: Stop Delivery Order: Safety Recall FL964

SAFETY RECALL NOTICE: On February 9, 2023, Daimler Truck North America (“DTNA”) filed a Defect Information Report (“DIR”) with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (“NHTSA”) informing the agency of our intent to conduct a voluntary safety recall.

Until further instructions are available, vehicles subject to this “Stop Delivery Order” must be held and not be delivered to customers.

Affected Vehicles:

On affected vehicles, the upper bunk mounting pivot bolt may loosen, resulting in the bunk potentially falling over and hitting the occupant. This may result in a safety risk to the vehicle's occupants.

Solution:

For all involved vehicles, a DTNA-authorized service facility will upgrade the current bolts and torque them to the correct specification. This recall action must be completed on all affected vehicles, at no charge to the vehicle owner.

Owner Notification Mailing Schedule:

Owner letters are expected to be mailed to affected customers during the week of April 3, 2023.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Dealers should make their personnel aware of this safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory, to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to the customer.

It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle, or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire), covered by this notification under a sale or lease, until the defect or noncompliance is remedied.
