Subject: Safety Recall RVXX2302, Hub Cover Removal

Description of Defect:

On certain trucks, the hub covers on the drive axles could come loose or detach while driving. A hub cover that detaches from the truck could create a road hazard for others and increase the risk of a crash.

Volvo dealer will remove the hub covers.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2024 Volvo VNR, VNL and VHD model vehicles manufactured from February 3, 2023 through March 4, 2023.

Vehicle Quantities:

Volvo 788 (726 US, 62 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal March 24, 2023.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before May 5, 2023.
- Repair Instruction will be released once they are available.
