



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 52A

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2021 through 2023 model year (WL) Jeep Grand Cherokee and Grand Cherokee L vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a missing dashboard airbag warning label. If a dashboard airbag warning label is missing, the occupant may not be aware of the risks a deploying airbag may pose to an infant or child occupying the front passenger seat.

Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard ("FMVSS") 571.208 Occupant Crash Protection states "...Vehicles certified to meet the requirements specified in S19, S21, and S23 on or after December 1, 2003, that are equipped with an inflatable restraint for the passenger position shall have a label attached to a location on the dashboard. The label need not be permanently affixed to the vehicle..."

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles. For vehicles that have been sold, FCA US will mail the owners a representative copy of the required label within the owner notification. For vehicles that have not been sold, FCA US will inspect, and, if necessary, install the required label. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2023.
