DEFECT DESCRIPTION

Certain trucks may not conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108 and/or Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (CMVSS) 108 - If any required lamp or reflective device is obstructed by motor vehicle equipment, the vehicle must be equipped with an additional lamp or device of the same type. Specifically, Navistar did not equip these vehicles with additional unobstructed back-up lamps. Back-up lamps that do not conform to all the requirements of FMVSS 108 and/or CMVSS 108 while in bobtail mode and in reverse with obstructed back-up lamps may increase the risk of a vehicle crash.

ELIGIBILITY

This procedure applies ONLY to vehicles marked in the International[®] Service Portal[™] with Safety Recall 23514.

PARTS INFORMATION

This interim service procedure requires no parts.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Advise your customers and other people that may be driving one of these vehicles to minimize the potential risk of this noncompliance, the operator should exercise greater caution while in bobtail mode and in reverse. Their back-up lamp may not be completely visible to someone behind them.

Should a customer call regarding this recall, please ensure they understand the same "Actions You Should Take", written in the interim notice they received in the mail.
