Please be advised that as of today, July 7, 2023, parts are currently available for the small population Accord (1 unit), Accord Hybrid (2 units), and Civic Hatch vehicles. For the Accord and Accord Hybrids, please ensure the vehicle is at your dealership prior to ordering. Please refrain from ordering for parts inventory, order parts for units currently in vehicle inventory and for customers that have an appointment. Details are under the following service bulletins:

- 23-058, Safety Recall: 2023 Civic Hatch Brake Hold, VSA Modulator,
- 23-059, Safety Recall: 2022 Accord Brake Hold, VSA Modulator, and
- 23-060, Safety Recall: 2022 Accord Hybrid Brake Hold, VSA Modulator

They include parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

SUMMARY

On June 15, 2023, American Honda notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for 245 units of model year 2022 Accord, 2022 Accord Hybrid, and 2023 Civic due to brake fluid leakage in the VSA modulator. Brake fluid leakage may affect the vehicle's ability to maintain brake pressure when the Brake Hold feature is engaged, potentially increasing the risk of a crash or injury. Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

As always, perform an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
