SUBJECT: Stop Delivery Order: Safety Recall FL978

SAFETY RECALL NOTICE On **June 28, 2023** Daimler Truck North America (“DTNA”) filed a Defect Information Report (“DIR”) with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (“NHTSA”) and/or a Defect Information Notice (“DIN”) with Transport Canada (“TC”) informing the agencies of our intent to conduct a voluntary safety recall.

It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. **Some of the vehicles subject to this "Stop Delivery Order" may be in your new vehicle inventory.** Until further instructions are available, **new vehicles subject to this “Stop Delivery Order” must be held and not be delivered to customers.**

DTNA strongly recommends that dealers and distributors remedy recalls before selling used vehicles. For any used vehicle with an open recall not remedied before sale, DTNA requires that the dealer or distributor notify prospective buyers of the open recall.

Problem:

On the affected vehicles, the service brake system may incorrectly calculate the vehicle mass, which can impair the electronic stability control system performance. As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 136, "Electronic Stability Control Systems on Heavy Vehicles."

Solution:

DTNA is preparing the remedy, which is currently under development.

Owner Notification Mailing Schedule: Owner letters will be mailed prior to the Campaign’s activation, currently scheduled is to be determined.
