



## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 77A**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2023 Model Year (RU) Chrysler Pacifica Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicles (PHEVs).

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have an improperly extruded fuel line which could lead to uncontained fuel in the engine compartment. Operators may observe a spill / drip or fuel odor. Uncontained fuel in the presence of a competent ignition source can result in a vehicle fire which increases the risk of injury to occupants and persons outside the vehicle, as well as property damage.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to inspect and, if necessary, replace the suspect fuel line. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2023.
