Subject: Safety Recall SC0447, Akasol Bus Bar
Recall Number: SRA-M447
Date: July 25, 2023
Applicable Markets: U.S. Canada Export

Description

On certain LRBE model vehicles the rivnut inserts on the batteries may have been over tightened and could fail. The nut inserts can then become debris in the battery which could result in a short inside the battery pack.

There have been no warranty claims, field reports, accidents or injuries reported with this issue.

The over tightening of the busbar rivnuts could result in nut inserts shearing off and shorting inside the battery which could result in a battery fire.

Model and Model Years Affected

- Certain MY2022 - 2023 Mack LR Electric vehicles manufactured November 16, 2021 through Jan 04, 2023.

Vehicle Quantities

- 14 (11 US, 3 Canada)

Dealer Responsibilities

- The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.
- Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Notification Release Schedule

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal July 28, 2023.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before September 15, 2023.
- Repair Instruction will be released once they are available.
