This is to notify you of the new Recall Campaign to inspect the front tow eye receiver on 11,853 Model Year ("MY") 2023 GLC (254 platform) vehicles. The recall campaign will be visible on the www.NHTSA.gov website and may generate questions from customers. Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on September 18, 2023.							
Background							
Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2023 GLC (254 platform) vehicles, the tow eye receiver in the front crossmember might not meet current specifications. In this case, the required depth of the threaded tow eye into the receiver might not be achieved. As a result, a loosening of the tow eye under load cannot be ruled out, which may increase the risk of crash or injury.					
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will inspect the front crossmember on the affected vehicles and replace it, if necessary.
