

## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

## **AUTOCAR, LLC ACX-2310 DC-2308** NHTSA RECALL NO. 23V656

TO: U.S. Distributors

Dealer Principals, Service Managers, Warranty Managers, Parts Managers

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain, 2022-2023 model year ACX (Xpeditor) and DC (Legend) chassis. The ACX chassis were manufactured between March 11, 2022, and June 27, 2023, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range of 238058 through 245684. The DC chassis were manufactured between April 20, 2022, and June 1, 2023, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range of 239500 through 245684. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective October 6, 2023.

**MODELS** AFFECTED: Autocar ACX (Xpeditor) and DC (Legend) MY 2022-2023

**COMPONENTS AFFECTED:** 

The steering column shaft pinch bolt may not be properly secured.

SAFETY **DEFECTS AND POTENTIAL** RISKS:

If the steering column shaft pinch bolt is not properly secured, it could come into contact with cab components and cause the steering to bind, resulting in a sudden

loss of steering, increasing the risk of a crash.

REPAIR **REQUIRED:**  The steering column shaft pinch bolts will be secured or replaced at no charge.

**REPAIR AVAILABLE:**  VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on November 27, 2023, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the

Warranty system.

**REMINDER:** 

It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to

violations of this law.
