Xos is recalling certain 2021-2022 SV05 vehicles. The electronic parking brake may malfunction or fail to engage without warning to the driver. Electronic parking brake failure may result in a vehicle rollaway, increasing the risk of a crash.

Xos and Xos authorized dealers will replace the affected hardware on the vehicle and update the vehicle software, free of charge. Xos will provide required parts and a software diagnostic tool to dealers once available. Please submit a service request to Xos to diagnose and repair any vehicles as required in the interim. Owner notification letters are expected to be mailed December 11, 2023.

Please be reminded that under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a)(3), it is illegal for a manufacturer to sell, offer for sale, import, or introduce or deliver into interstate commerce, a motor vehicle or item of motor vehicle equipment that contains a safety defect once the manufacturer has notified NHTSA about that safety defect.
