Issue	Sprinter (907 platform) vehicles, the longitudinal frame members of the body-in-white might not meet		
	specifications. Missing reinforcements might lead to damage in the rear area of the longitudinal frame		
	members. Over time, impairment of driving stability cannot be ruled out. In addition, vehicles equipped		
	with a bench seat in the 3rd passenger seat row, could experience a failure of the seat mountings in the		
	event of a crash. In this case, the risk of injury would increase.
