This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

GILLIG has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain torque rods sold as aftermarket replacement equipment due to possible interference with the vehicle wiring harness.

As a result of the above, GILLIG has decided to voluntarily initiate a safety campaign to recall those rods that may be affected by the issue.

<u>What The Issue Is:</u> The SAF torque rod part no. 83-07738-000 was approved to be a backwards compatible replacement of the Tenneco torque rod part no. 82-74712-001 installed as original equipment of the rear suspension of the vehicle. However, the geometry of the SAF rod may potentially interfere with certain safety-related circuits during vehicle operations causing system faults. If a safetyrelated circuit is impacted, the driver may experience loss of vehicle control in certain circumstances with increased risk of a crash.

What We Are Asking
You To Do:Identify the affected parts according to the information provided
by GILLIG.

<u>What GILLIG Will Do</u> <u>For You:</u> GILLIG will provide you with the affected part number and invoice date to help you to identify the rods affected by this recall.

GILLIG will also provide you with replacement rods (Part No. 82-74712-001) at no cost to you.
