NHTSA RECALL 23V-001

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE, VIN: [REDACTED]

Dear Volvo Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Volvo Car USA LLC on behalf of Volvo Car Group, have decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2019-2022 60 and 90 series vehicles.

The reason for Recall R10213:

Volvo Car investigations have identified that a Steering Gear manufacturing error, in the supplier's assembly process, has in rare cases installed double screws on top of each other. There is a risk of the steering wheel locking up due to the first screw falling into the gearbox housing, increasing the risk of a crash.

Recall action: R10213:

The corrective action is to replace the Steering Gear, **free of charge**.

Please contact your authorized Volvo retailer to schedule an appointment for the repair to be completed. This procedure will be completed at no cost and can take up to five hours to complete, however due to service scheduling your Volvo retailer may require your vehicle for a longer period.

If you had previously paid for this repair to be performed, prior to receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
