This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Lordstown EV Corporation (“Lordstown”, “we”, or “us”) has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2023 Lordstown Endurance vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles.

| What is the issue? | On your vehicle, a high-voltage cable assembly between an inverter and a hub motor may lose high-voltage isolation. |
| What is the risk? | If high-voltage isolation is lost, then the vehicle may suffer an unexpected reduction of power and eventual loss of propulsion and once the vehicle is turned off it cannot be restarted. This could result in an increased risk of a crash. |
| What will Lordstown do? | Lordstown will replace each of the four (4) high-voltage cable assemblies on your vehicle at no charge to you. The repair is expected to take about 8 hours to complete. |
| What are your next steps? | If Lordstown has not already performed this repair, please contact Lordstown at 1-855-RIDE-LMC (1-855-743-3562) or customerservice@lordstownmotors.com to schedule an appointment for Lordstown to perform this repair. |
| What if you no longer own this vehicle? | If you no longer own your vehicle, and have an address for the current owner, please forward this letter to the new owner and also let us know that you no longer own the vehicle. |
