If the incorrect bolts were used, the bolts will not properly engage the locking feature of the retaining nuts, which may allow the safety chains to become separated from the drawbar.

## DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY POSSIBLE

Loss of the safety chains may increase the risk of separation of the trailer and tow vehicle, in the event the drawbars on affected trailers fail or become disconnected unexpectedly. **Death or serious injury is possible.** Property or equipment damage may also occur.
